The Safety Net Alliance of Northern Kentucky is a collaboration of organizations whose mission is to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of emergency assistance services provided to Northern Kentucky's low-income families. The SNA is a ground-breaking collaborative of social service agencies, government entities, and funding organizations that meet regularly to address issues that affect Northern Kentucky families.

Who We Are & What We Do

Formed in 2007, the Safety Net Alliance of Northern Kentucky was created to eliminate an overlapping of resources in order to better serve Northern Kentucky residents in need.

Representatives from dozens of partner agencies attend meetings on the third Wednesday of every month, from 12pm to 1:30pm, at the Brighton Center's Family Center in Newport, KY. Lunch is provided for every meeting, with attendees providing their own drinks. Speakers for the meetings alternate monthly from outside of the Alliance and within the Alliance. Topics at meetings include but are not limited to: Funding, available resources, upcoming events, miscellaneous updates, and committee progress.

Services within the Alliance

Services from partner agencies in the Safety Net Alliance include: Food programs, emergency assistance, senior services, home repair/weatherization, information about government services (KCHIP, K-TAP, WIC, SNAP), housing resources, event information (seasonal, fundraisers, etc.), clothing, disability or disease help, plus many more.
